Council for Licensed Conveyancers (CLC) applications for designation as an Approved Regulator and Licensing Authority for the reserved legal activities of conduct of litigation and exercise of rights of audience

As you are aware, at its meeting on 28 March 2012, the Board concluded that it could not grant the applications for a recommendation that the CLC be designated as an approved regulator and licensing authority for the reserved legal activities of conduct of litigation and exercise of rights of audience. I enclose with this letter the formal Notice that sets out the decision and the reasons for it.

As we have discussed, this decision does not in any way affect the CLC current designations. Indeed, as is noted in the Decision Notice this process has given us a degree of assurance on the effectiveness of the CLC as a regulator in relation to its current legal activities. As we have agreed, my team are willing to work with you towards resolution of the issues that have led us to this decision.
