2. Exact rules the LSB enforces when firms share details with authorities.
3. Statistics - how many breaches, fines or penalties issued since May 2026.
4. The exact legal basis solicitors use to keep or share my data.

5. Full name & direct contact of the person in charge of this collection.

Response

1. The LSB does not hold this information. You may be able to find details of the data handling retention and disclosure policy of each regulator on their websites.
2. The LSB is the oversight regulator and we do not regulate individual legal services providers or legal firms. We therefore do not have such information.
3. Your request is not clear as you have not specified the types of breaches, fines or penalty information you seek. Nonetheless, the LSB does not hold this information.
4. This is a matter that should be addressed to each firm from whom you seek copies of your personal data. The LSB is not able to assist.
